Volunteer Committee Chair	Awards Committee Chair – 15 hours	Fundraiser Committee member
Fundraiser Chair	Christmas Ice Recital Chair/Co-Chair – 20 hours	Volunteer Committee member
	Ice Show cast member – 5 hours per show	Monthly board meetings – 1 hour per meeting attended. Spring meeting – 2 hours.
